VUB Spring Semester Information and Instructions

Page three of the newsletter contains the VUB 2014 Spring Semester schedule of classes. It is very similar to previous semesters and it contains all the pre-college class opportunities for most veterans to prepare for entrance into and success in a post-secondary program.

We will continue our basic math and English classes this semester by offering tutoring for those who need to brush up on their basic skills. Please call the VUB office to arrange this individual service. We will continue to provide tutoring for those who need additional preparation before taking the COMPASS test.

Please note that one class meets twice per week (computer skills), while the remainder meets only once per week (algebra, literature, science and statistics). Also note that the semester is ten weeks in length.

Check out the schedule and contact any VUB staff if vou member have questions. To register for classes follow the instructions at the bottom of the page. You may register by phone, by e-mail, or you may remove the page, fold it so that the VUB address is on the outside, staple/ tape it and mail to us not later than January 23, 2014.

We recommend that all participants register for at least two courses so that you will receive the full benefit of the instruction and be better prepared when you enter a post-secondary program.

We have designed the schedule so that you will be able to register for up to six different classes during a four-day period without class conflicts.

If you are in college already, keep us informed of your progress, call if you need help, and let us know if you change your address or phone number. Have a great Spring!

2012-2013 Post-Secondary Enrollment

Page two of the newsletter lists VUB's post-secondary enrollment of 52 for the past year.

VUB students were placed in 11 different schools, colleges, and other post-secondary programs. This is a record number of college placements for VUB. The initiation of VA's new program, Veterans Retraining and Assistance Program (VRAP), which restricted veterans to approved programs of education or training offered by a community college or a technical school leading to an associate degree or certificate, significantly contributed to the increase.

We are saddened by the untimely deaths of two of our college placements: Darrell Fleming, a U.S. Navy veteran who was attending Hopkinsville Community College in Kentucky, and William Parrott, a United States Marine Corps veteran who was attending Tennessee College of Applied Technology in Elizabethton, Tennessee.
