- I. President Hopson called the meeting to order at 2:30 p.m.
- II. President Hopson welcomed senators and Dr. Norma McRae, Dr. David Logan, and Dr. Linda Garceau. Their presentation was to obtain input from the Staff Senate on the Reorganization of Academic Affairs and Student Support Services. The project has broad boundaries to include all of ETSU except the College of Medicine. The committee thanked the senate for their suggestions and ideas.
