This policy change has been discussed at length at several council meetings. Program coordinators have been contacted and given their thoughts on this. This policy was approved pending approval from the ETSU Board of Trustees. Dr. Kirkby will draft the wording that will go in the catalog. c. DNP Progression Policy, Dr. Hemphill

DNP progression policy:

- 1. Students in graduate nursing programs must meet the requirements of the School of Graduate Studies to remain in good standing. An overall grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 (B) or better must be maintained.
- 2. In addition, a nursing student must achieve a "B" or better in every graduate nursing course. Policies of the School of Graduate Studies for progression will apply.
- 3. DNP students who receive less than a "B" in a course will have one opportunity to repeat the course.

This policy was discussed and Dr. Jean Hemphill will be taking this back to the faculty for further review.
