With a quorum present, Peggy Cantrell called the meeting to order at 3:33 PM.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

REPORTS FROM STANDING COMMITTEES

Academic Matters Peggy Cantrell reported that the Faculty Senate's Pre-finals Week Recommendation was amended and endorsed as policy by the Academic Council.

Mark Hagy reported that the committee will soon be working on the issues of plus/minus grades and transfer grades.

Committee on Committees Mark Steadman reported that the committee is in the process of mailing out sign-up sheets for committee nominations. Upon return of the sign-up sheets, the committee will fill the open slots.

Concerns and Grievances Steven Berk reported that the committee's recommendation about faculty emeritus status has been submitted to the President's Council for their decision.

The committee has received two proposals for faculty professional liability insurance from insurance companies. The committee is reviewing the proposals.

Faculty Development and Evaluation Laura McCammon reported that the committee has withdrawn the second of the recommendations about SAI that were submitted to the Faculty Senate for consideration at the March 20, 1995 meeting.

Laura McCammon announced that the committee is sponsoring a seminar, Student Evaluation of Instruction: Limits, Myths, and Ways to Improve Its Use, April 11, 1995, 2:00pm - 4:15pm, Dining Room 1, Culp Center. Announcements have been sent to the Faculty Senate mailing list, and those receiving them are asked to share the information with other faculty.

Laura McCammon announced that the Teaching and Learning Center has been funded.

Peggy Cantrell reported that there was a video conference, Enhancing and Evaluating College Teaching & Learning, on Friday, in the Culp Center, March 31, 1995. Dr. Cantrell recommends the conference as excellent, and there is a copy available in the IMC.

Research Terry Tollefson reported that he met with Dr. Bev Normant recently. Dr. Tollefson asked the members of the Research Committee to meet with him following the Faculty Senate meeting.
